### **Williamson College Announces Honors Program**

FRANKLIN, Tenn. (March 15, 2013) –Williamson College announced today that it will begin an honors program starting in July. To qualify, students need to have a 3.5 GPA; a 28 ACT or 1920 SAT/1280 SAT without writing test addition; a written essay; and character references.

The Williamson College Honors Program also has an international component, an internship requirement and requires regular engagement with a mentor. Honors students must possess excellent written and verbal communication skills.

“We are excited to offer the new honors program,” said Dr. Sharon Landers, Academic Dean for Williamson College. “This is a great opportunity for qualifying students to enrich their academic program with international study, internships, to work with a mentor, and have opportunities to utilize and enhance their communication skills.”
